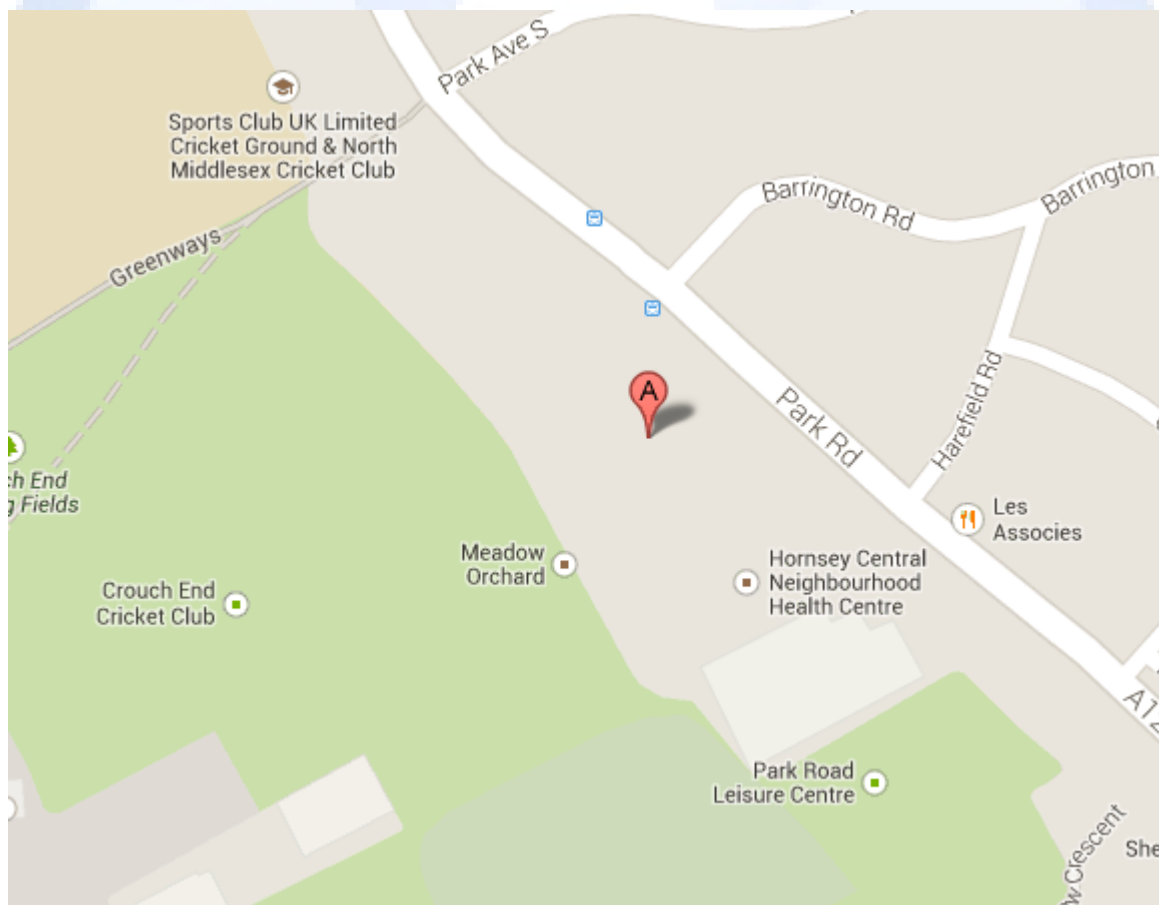

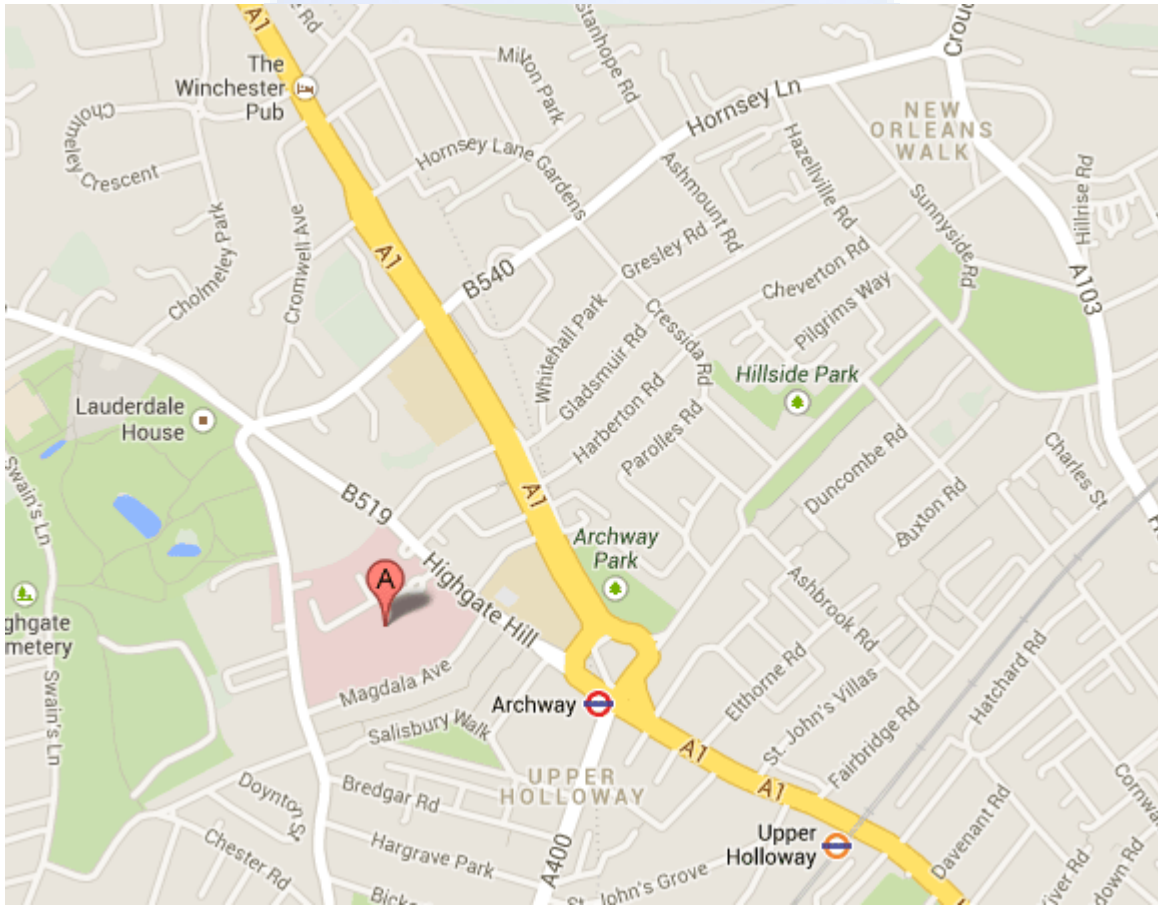

Take the W5 or 41 busses from Crouch End to Archway, walk up Highgate Hill and the hospital can be found on the left. Main entrance is located on Magdala Avenue, the A&E entrance is located at the rear of the hospital.



- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation. Is there danger of
- Is there a risk of further injury?
- Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the qualified First Aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.

- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services – **999**.
- The telephone number for NHS Direct is: **111** or see www.nhsdirect.nhs.uk
- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised and safe.
- Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency medics.
- Contact the injured person's parent / carer / guardian.
- Complete an Incident / Accident Report Form.
